

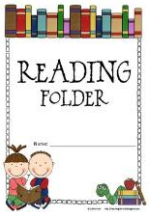
# Central Elementary Title I Reading Newsletter

Dear Parents/Guardians of Title I students,

The testing window for the End-of-the-Year DIBELS assessments starts next week. The Title I teachers will be giving the DIBELS assessments to ALL students in Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> grade, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade over the next few weeks. During the testing window, Title I students might not come to Title 1 every day. We'll work with our students as much as possible, but we're also going to be helping to give the ILEARN assessments to the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grades in addition to giving the DIBELS assessments. Once all of the assessments are over, we'll go back to our normal schedules. I highly encourage students to work on **Boost Reading** and/or the **mCLASS Intervention Practice App** as much as possible during this testing window since I won't be able to work with them on a daily basis.



**Practice books** will be sent home with students when possible during the testing window. Please continue to initial the **Activity Log** when your child has finished reading and send them back to school daily. Since we'll be testing for the next several weeks, your child might not be able to pick a new book each day.

I've made a handout of the **Goals for the DIBELS Assessments**. It has some of the specific skills and words that will be tested on the End-of-the-Year (E.O.Y) DIBELS assessments for each grade level. Feel free to go over these pages and have your child practice reading them. Students will have 1 minute for each assessment. The MAZE for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade will be 3 minutes long (*instead of just 1 minute*). They can practice MAZE on their chrome books at any time (*2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students only*).
