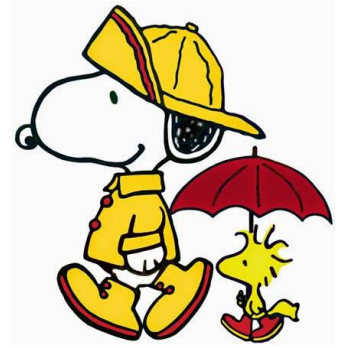


Central Elementary Title I Reading Newsletter

Dear Parents/Guardians of Title I students,

We started the End-of-the-Year DIBELS assessments this week along with the ILEARN assessments. I tried to work at least once this week with all of my students so I could start their DIBELS assessments. I'll continue to do this until all of testing is finished. I highly encourage students to work on Boost Reading and/or the mCLASS Intervention practice App as much as possible during this testing window since I won't be able to work with all of my students on a daily basis.

I also encourage you to continue to go over the sheet that I sent home with the Goals for the DIBELS Assessments. Students will have 1 minute for each assessment. The MAZE for 2nd and 3rd grade will be 3 minutes long (*instead of just 1 minute*). They can also practice MAZE on their chrome books at any time (*2nd and 3rd grade students only*).



Practice books will continue to be sent home with students when possible during the testing window. Please continue to initial the Activity Log when your child has finished reading and send them back to school daily. Since we'll be testing for the next several weeks, your child might not be able to pick a new book each day. I have several students that are missing the book that I sent. Please have them look for it at home and return it to school in their folder as soon as possible. Thanks!
