“Read Across America Day” is Saturday, March 2nd so celebrated it today by focusing on rhythm and rhyming words while practicing reading with feeling and expression.

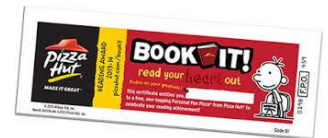
Reading Dr. Seuss books are a wonderful way to practice these skills!
