Title I Reading Books: The students are bringing home a book and/or activity in their folder today to practice reading at home. This is **not** homework, but just extra reading practice. Some of the books are very easy and are meant to practice fluency. If the book/activity is too hard, please help your child as needed so he/she doesn't become frustrated. I want this to be a fun and positive learning experience for them. 😊 When your child has finished reading the book, please sign/initial the bright green **Take Home Activity Log** so I know that your child is ready for another book/activity. Again, this does NOT need to be done every night. Feel free to spend several nights reading the same book if needed so your child feels confident and can read it quickly and correctly. You can also ask questions about the story to check comprehension. (*See the attached paper for suggestions).



***Please be sure to keep the books and progress papers in their folders/bags & RETURN them all to school daily.** 😊

Progress Monitoring & Behavior Reports: Please remember to initial the boxes to let me know you've seen their updated scores (if you haven't already). I'm also sending home the October **Boost Reading reports**. You can see their usage, progress, and current skills/activities. We encourage students to work 30-45 minutes each week in Boost.
