 - a. Kindergarten: Teacher Rank, Letter Naming (LNF) and Phoneme Segmentation Fluency (PSF)

 - d. mCLASS Intervention lessons: created every 2 weeks based on progress monitoring scores
 - Our Title I Reading program is designed to teach literacy skills in a direct, explicit, multisensory, structured, sequential, diagnostic, and prescriptive way. This will allow students to build necessary literacy skills, gain confidence and increase fluency in Reading.
 - b. The goal of the Title I program is to help students reach grade-level or above in Reading.
