1. Explanation of **Title I Program**, DIBELS, mCLASS Intervention and the Identification Process.
 - a. Kindergarten: Teacher Rank, Letter Naming (LNF) and Phoneme Segmentation Fluency (PSF)
 - b. 1st Grade: Teacher Rank, Nonsense Word Fluency-Words Read Correctly (NWF-WRC), Oral Reading Fluency (ORF-FLU)
 - c. 2nd Grade: Teacher Rank, Nonsense Word Fluency-Words Read Correctly (NWF-WRC), Oral Reading Fluency (ORF-FLU)
 - d. **mCLASS Intervention lessons**: created every 2 weeks based on progress monitoring scores
 - a. Our Title I Reading program is designed to teach literacy skills in a direct, explicit, multisensory, structured, sequential, diagnostic, and prescriptive way. This will allow students to build necessary literacy skills, gain confidence and increase fluency in Reading.
 - b. The goal of the Title I program is to help students reach grade-level or above in Reading.
