

# Title I Reading “Weekly Focus” for Jan. 16-26, 2024

## Kindergarten:

**Overview:** Kindergarten students will work in small groups in the Title I Reading classroom for about 30 minutes each day of the week. Students will receive instruction in the form of mCLASS Intervention lessons and Boost Reading lessons. The mCLASS Intervention lessons are initially created based on the results of the middle-of-the-year DIBELS assessments. The lessons are regularly updated based on the results of each student’s DIBELS progress monitoring scores that are conducted every two weeks. The students will also work on their chrome books to complete Boost Reading lessons and/or on the ipads to work on the mCLASS Intervention Practice App. A placement test is given at the beginning of the semester to determine the starting point for each student. Then each student works at his/her own pace to complete the lessons that are assigned specifically for him/her. The lessons are designed to provide differentiation for each student in order to help every student succeed.

**Objectives:** Students will practice **Phonological Awareness** and **Letter Sound Knowledge**.
