The lessons are regularly updated based on the results of each student's DIBELS progress monitoring scores that are conducted every two weeks. The students will also work on their chrome books to complete Boost Reading lessons and/or on the ipads to work on the mCLASS Intervention Practice App. A placement test is given at the beginning of the semester to determine the starting point for each student. Then each student works at his/her own pace to complete the lessons that are assigned specifically for him/her.
